



STEPS TO FORMULATION

- DETERMINE THE NATURAL LEVEL (NL)**
Match the natural level of the hair using the INTENSE Natural Series on the Framcolor 2001 INTENSE swatch card.
- DETERMINE THE DESIRED LEVEL (DL)**
Determine the final desired level. Is the client going darker, lighter, or staying the same color level?
- DETERMINE THE TONAL VALUE OF THE DESIRED LEVEL (warm, cool, neutral)**
The Guiding Principal of Color: The remaining color at lift level + framesi color base = final tone.

Remaining color may be enhanced or refined depending on desired results. Refer to the color wheel and series/bases.
- DETERMINE THE CORRECT ACTIVATOR**
See FRAMESI PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATOR Chart

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Mix 30cc (1 oz.) of Framcolor 2001 INTENSE with 60cc (2 oz.) of the appropriate FRAMESI PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATOR.
- Apply color mixture to the hair and process in half the traditional time!
- Rinse, shampoo and proceed with styling according to chart below.
- For unlimited creativity, mix 50% Framcolor 2001 INTENSE with any Framcolor 2001 shade and process in half the traditional time!

COMPLETING THE COLOR SERVICE

When the color process is complete, rinse and shampoo with Shampoo Go. Rinse. Apply Post Color, and without rinsing, apply Mask directly on top. Retain 2-3 minutes. Rinse.

CONVERSION CHART

1 Tube = 60cc
60cc = 2 oz.
1 Tube = 2 Color Applications
1 Color Application = 30cc or 1 oz.



PRELIMINARY TEST STRAND / PATCH TEST

Prior to the application of color, the FDA requires that you perform a simple patch test to determine if the person is allergic to the color dye, and that the test is performed 24-48 hours prior to each application behind the ear or in the bend of the elbow.

If redness, burning, itching, small blisters or any other type of eruption appears in the general area used for the skin test during the first 24-48 hours, the individual is sensitive to the dye, and under no circumstances should it be used for dyeing the hair.

To formulate for desired color, use formula in minute form: 4 ribbon inches of desired shade and 10cc of developer

EXAMPLE:

Formula 30cc (1 oz.) of 5.00 with 60cc (2 oz.) of FRAMESI PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATOR 20
• Test Strand/Patch-test 4 ribbon inches of 5.00 + 10cc FRAMESI PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATOR 20

Note: Patch test formulation must be the exact same formula to be used on the client. Do not use Framcolor 2001 INTENSE on eyelashes, eyebrows, beards, or facial hair.

COLOR THEORY

Color may be warm or cool, depending on amount of blue, red, and yellow contained in each color. When you mix primary colors, you create secondary colors.

Orange = Red + Yellow

Violet = Red + Blue

Green = Blue + Yellow

When you mix primary and secondary colors, you create tertiary colors.

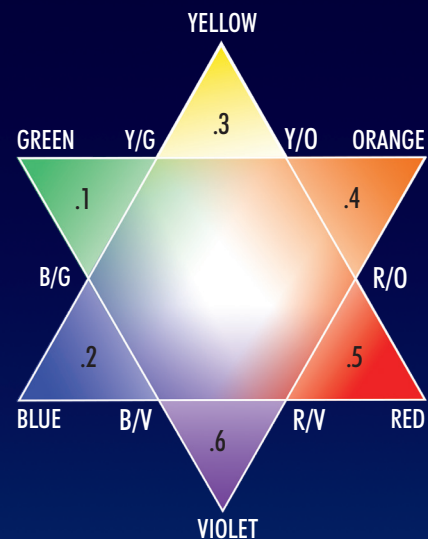
- Yellow/Orange
- Red/Orange
- Red/Violet
- Blue/Violet
- Blue/Green
- Yellow/Green

When working with the color when, you can:

- Work around the wheel - to create color
- Work across the wheel - to refine color



NUMBERING SYSTEM KEY			
	Level is denoted by the left most number		
.	a separation mark between level and description		
00	denotes INTENSE Naturals		
0	denotes INTENSE		
1	GREEN	4	ORANGE
2	BLUE	5	RED
3	YELLOW	6	VIOLET

Do you want to enhance the remaining color?
Choose a base by working around the wheel.

Do you want to counteract the remaining color?
Choose a base by working across the wheel.

Remember, the law of color applies in all coloring processes.
